Rising Star nominee Kaylah Anne a popCountry Girl on ABC label

Things seem to be moving for Starmaker grand finalist Kaylah Anne ever since the release of her self titled EP just over a year ago.

Her world of singing, songwriting, and live gigs has exploded, largely due to the release of her second single and debut film clip, the title track, Why Me.

In May, ABC signed the nineteen year old from Newcastle to a non-exclusive agreement releasing Why Me in cd and dvd format on its compilation popCountry Girl. Launched online on Friday 7 August, product is available through the ABC shop in stores and online.

Why Me's infectious and assertive lyrics, a triumph of sorts for the young songwriter, are creatively portrayed in the picture perfect clip by NanNud Media producer Duncan Toombs. Why Me hit the Top 50 CMC Charts earlier this year.

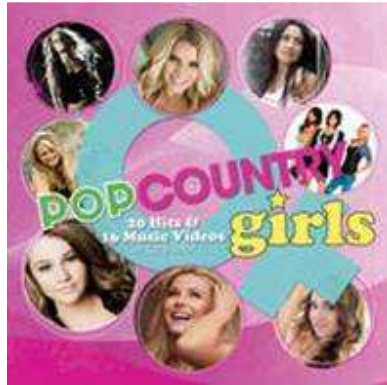
Kaylah told Capital News' Deborah Minter back in February 'Why Me was written about a boy I met in Sydney.'

'I was down visiting a friend for her birthday and that's the night I met him. I went home on such a high and being the girl I am, I started fantasising about what it would be like if we fell in love. So I wrote a song about it, thinking he would listen to it and fall madly in love with me, like they do in the movies. It didn't quite work out that way, but I got a good song out of it so I'm not complaining.'

With all the energy about, the moving forward is fast becoming a daily news story. It seems the ABC launch just happened to be the same day Kaylah received the news she was a 'Rising Star' finalist in Mildura's thirteenth annual awards The Southern Stars in October.
